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A Case Report on Adult Onset of Still's Disease

Adult onset Still disease (AOSD) is a rare systemic inflammatory disorder characterized by fever, inflammatory polyarthritis, and a transient salmon-pink maculopapular rash. In this study patient was presented with high grade fever, knee joint pain along with tenderness and was treated with steroids and antibiotics and adopted Yamaguchi criteria to diagnose still's disease. The patient was stable before discharge.
