A Review on Ovarian Cyst

Abstract:

Ovarian cysts in women and are usually found out during examination for other conditions including pregnancy or during scans for underlying diseases. Itis not life-threatening; most of them disappear on their own, and do not require surgery. Preventive care includes using oral contraceptives and can be managed using Non-Steroidal Anti-inflammatory Drugs such as KETOPROFEN, INDOMETHACIN and Narcotic analgesics such as MORPHINE SULPHATE, OXYCODONE. Surgeries can be performed if larger than 5-10cm including laparotomy, laparoscopy, and oophorectomy.
