INTRODUCTION

Hyperparathyroidism may be secondary to parathyroid hyperplasia, adenoma or carcinoma. Increased secretion of parathyroid hormone results in increased bone resorption, increased intestinal absorption of calcium, and decreased renal clearance of calcium. This will lead to increased serum calcium concentration which is responsible for most of the manifestations of the disease.

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
