Thrombocytopenia occurs when the platelet count falls below the normal range value that is 1,50,000 cells / microliter of blood.

Objective:

To study the recovery of thrombocytopenia in different people.

Method:

A prospective study of thrombocytopenia cause, symptoms, diagnosis and treatment of a individual patient in a hospital.

Results:


Out of 20 patients, 10 patients recovered without a transfusion of the platelets with supportive treatment and ten patients recovered with transfusion of platelets when the platelet count falls below 20,000 or 30,000 cells/micro liter of blood volume and transfusion also depends on the severity of the patient's condition.

Conclusion:

Ten patients recovered with transfusion of Platelets when platelets count falls to 20,000 or 30,000 cells/micro liter. Ten patients recovered without transfusion of platelets.
