Geographical Distribution of Covid-19 Unlocking Effects on Psychological Problems

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ABSTRACT

Background: - The COVID-19 pandemic is a unique challenge to humanity in recent times. The psychological impact and stress during the unlocking period in a pandemic would likely to be huge and challenging to the human race.

Objective: - This survey is conducted to know the Geographical Distribution of Covid-19 unlocking effects on psychological problem and how stressed people are in this current scenario to build up their confidence level.

Materials and Methodology: - An online study that was directed utilizing Google forms and link was sent utilizing WhatsApp, Facebook, and Instagram. A self- answered questionnaire survey was utilized for the investigation. The study poll would take 4-5 min to finish.

Result: - A total of 496 participants from which 473 were from different zones of Gujarat and 23 were from other states of India. Among all the participants 272 (54.8%) were male and 223 (45%) were female and 1 (0.2%) chose other. Among all of them, 30.8% did not face any financial issue, 5.8% had family/relationship issue, 23% of the participants were feeling stressed for their future career due to pandemic. 18.1% of participants were extremely stressed, going outside even after talking about all the precautions.

Conclusion: - From survey report, it was found that there were significant increase in the issues after the unlock in a particular zone.
