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RESERPINE INDUCED PARKINSONISM

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ABSTRACT

The present article discusses the case of a 53 years old female patient with a history of taking Reserpine (Rauwolfia Serpentina) for the treatment of hypertension since ten years and revealing symptoms similar to Parkinsonism. This case study reflects the need for the thorough follow-up of patients receiving reserpine. The treatment approaches to manage these symptoms are explained in this case report.
